The State of Missouri will approve new installations with Video/Text Emergency Communication system, if required by a municipality that has adopted and enforces 2018 International Building Code section 3001.2.

The Video/ Text Emergency Communication means will conform to the A17.1-2019 Section 2.27.

A Variance approval by the Elevator Safety Board will be required for all new installations that include Video/ Text Emergency Communications Means.

Instructions for inspecting this equipment will be included as part Maintenance Control Program, On-Site Documentation.

The State Data Base will furnish A17.1-2019 (2.27) code violation sections for use in inspection reports.
